1997 – BEEL BHAINA BREACH: BIRTH OF TRM
Community villagers, including women and farmers, breaching an earthen embankment with spades and bamboo poles. Tidal water rushing into a floodplain. Green shoots emerging from newly deposited silt. Faces of cautious hope and relief

In 1997, people in Beel Bhaina breached the embankment themselves. Tidal water reentered; the beel began to heal. Agriculture and ecology revived. Tidal River Management (TRM) was born -- from the people, not planners






1998–2000 — STATE REPRESSION & CRIMINALIZATION

2000–2001 – Formation of Paani Committee


With Uttaran's support, the Paani Committee was formed. A decentralized civil platform led by those most affected. Represented the grassroots voice for river justice







TRM integrated into national Delta Plan 2100. But actual implementation slowed. Overgrown TRM sites, canals, and abandoned projects misapplied, community voices sidelined again. Farmers waiting in line with compensation claims. Recognizing resources impacted.




