

On-Air for Gender-
Inclusive Nature-based
Climate Solutions



The project supports local sub-Saharan African communities, particularly women and youth, in implementing nature-based solutions for climate adaptation using Farm Radio International's wide radio network and its innovative approaches to design, produce and air gender-responsive, interactive and local radio programs.

The project aims to ensure a just and gender-responsive enabling environment for nature-based solutions to help local communities address their climate adaptation needs.

Project activities include: (1) engaging with climate adaptation specialists, in-country stakeholders, women-led rights groups and relevant knowledge partners in the targeted communities to extract content priorities relevant to their expressed climate change adaptation needs; (2) designing, producing and airing the gender-responsive, interactive High-Impact Radio Series to significantly expand access to information about nature-based solutions for climate adaptation across sub-Saharan Africa; and (3) engaging with the Canadian public to inform them about the adaptation needs of countries in sub-Saharan Africa and how nature-based solutions can be part of the solution.

Approximately 2% of the total contribution area overlaps with Key Biodiversity Areas.
